OSAA Foundation Equity and Diversity Fund

The OSAA Foundation has established a fund to support schools with their Equity and Diversity initiatives. Schools can apply for up to \$2,000 in total value.

Applying schools must write a formal letter for application and a detailed plan about how the funds will be spent. Applications may be submitted throughout the school year. Each application will be reviewed by the OSAA Foundation Staff and approved by the OSAA Foundation Board. Incomplete applications will not be reviewed. This project is open to all full member schools. Recipients will be notified at the conclusion of each application cycle.

From literature, to guest speakers, to additional training beyond what's provided by the OSAA – the OSAA Foundation is looking for innovative ideas from schools about the engagement of Equity and Diversity training with their staff, their students and their communities. Successful grants should be able to provide budgets, sustainability plans and detail the support from their administration. Funds from the project cannot include staffing (FTE) or be set aside for future use.

The OSAA Foundation will confirm receipt of the application. One application per school per academic year. Recipients of project funding will not be able to apply for funds the following academic year. Funds must be used within one calendar year of receipt.
